2. Daily activities - a wide range of daily activities to take place throughout the week.

Students are encouraged not to opt for the same activity two years running. A variety of experiences is important. It is necessary for all students to take part in Active Learning Week.

BOOKINGS WILL BE TAKEN FROM TUESDAY 6th MARCH 2018 – please return the booking form and deposit early to avoid disappointment. Returning the form and deposit does not guarantee a place on the first choice activity and, if your son/daughter is unsuccessful, their deposit will be allocated against their second choice activity. Where activities are oversubscribed a draw may take place for those who have returned their booking forms before 9.10am on 6th March. Please note that deposits are not refundable once a place has been confirmed and retention of your child's place on their chosen activity is dependent on meeting the payment deadlines set for each activity.

It is not possible to use Parent Pay to make the deposit payment as this is required with the booking form. All further payments for the confirmed activities can be paid using Parent Pay.

I am sure that Active Learning Week 2018 will be a great success. Please read the following information carefully as it provides further details of how to make your choices, the costs involved and an outline of each activity.

Musical Production

During Active Learning Week rehearsals will be taking place for the College's musical production of Sister Act. Those students wishing to take part in this production please see Mr Strike or Mrs Mason and enter this as their choice on the form – please see the booklet for further details on the production.

Please take note of the following:

- **Confirmation of place** – once the activity leader has approved the list of students, a confirmation letter will be sent out to parents confirming their child's place and detailing when any additional payments are due. Reserve lists will be held.
- **Poor behaviour** – on the rare occasion that we have to send a student back from an activity for poor behaviour, the parents/carers of the child will be expected to make arrangements for them to be collected as soon as possible. We also reserve the right to remove your child from a trip due to poor behaviour prior to Active Learning Week, at which point you will be liable for any costs incurred by the College in relation to your child's place on the trip.
- **College day** – all activities will take place during the normal College day. Transport to and from College will be as normal.
- **Payments** – the confirmation letter will detail the payment instalment due dates for the chosen activity. Please note that all payments are non-refundable and dates must be strictly adhered to in order to retain your son/daughter's place on the trip. Final payments will be due no later than 25th May 2018.

SURFING



Code: 1 Cost: £165.00 (£30 deposit) Places available: 15

Learn to surf the waves. This activity is for all surfers – whether you are a beginner or have surfed before.

2 days will be spent learning to surf at Bude

2 days will be based at Upper Tamar Lakes learning to windsurf and sail

1 day will be spent at North Devon Wakepark taking part in a wakeboarding lesson and then a session on the inflatable Aqua Park.

The cost of this activity includes all transport, safety wear and hire of equipment. All these activities are led by qualified instructors.

You will need to bring swimwear, a towel and old trainers/surf shoes that can get wet each day. You will need to provide your own lunch and drinks each day.

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### WET'n'WILD



Code: 2      Cost: £184.00 (£50 deposit)      Places available: 30

This activity is an all week activity departing daily from the College. Be prepared to be challenged, have fun and get wet.

Activities will be:-

2 days coastering and kayking at Polzeath/Port Quin

2 days abseiling and surfing at Widemouth Bay.

1 day at Splashdown@Quaywest Waterpark, Paignton

You will need to provide your own lunch and drinks each day.

The cost of this activity includes all transport, safety wear and hire of equipment. All these activities are led by qualified instructors. You will need old trainers or surfing shoes for the coastering activity.

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ADVENTURE WEEK



Code: 3 Cost: £145.00 (£30 deposit) Places available: 60

This is an all week activity departing daily from the College. Be prepared to be challenged and have fun.

Activities will be:-

- 1 day - kayaking and raft building at Alder Lake
- 1 day – mountain biking at Gulworthy
- 1 day – treesurfing & high ropes at Gulworthy
- 1 day – canoe safari at Cothele Quay
- 1 day – Go-karting and laser tag

You will need to provide your own lunch and drinks for each day.

The cost of this activity includes all transport, safety wear and hire of equipment. All of these activities are led by qualified instructors.

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## HORSE RIDING



Code: 4      Cost: £152.50 (£30 deposit)      Places available: 24

If you are keen to develop your riding skills or want to learn how to ride, this course is for you. Whatever your ability, there will be a chance to improve with expert tuition. Each day will be a mixture of riding lessons, practical stable management and learning about caring for a horse. Be prepared – you will be expected to help 'muck out'.

You may have the chance to work towards BHS Progress Certificates. At the end of the week there will be a competition (with rosettes).

You will need to arrange your own transport to and from the stables (at Polson). You will need to provide your own lunch and drinks for the day.

Special clothing will not be required and hard hats are provided by the stables. Remember to wear suitable footwear.

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SKIING / SNOWBOARDING



Code: 5 Cost: £121.00 (£30 deposit) Places available: 45

We will be travelling to the Aspen of the South West – Plymouth Ski Centre at Marsh Mills. You will be able to learn to ski or snowboard your way through the week. Please specify on the booking form your choice - either 'Ski' or 'Board'. All groups will be with qualified instructors.

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday the groups will be either skiing or snowboarding. Friday will give students the chance to Toboggan and Sno-tube in the morning and then return to their chosen activity in the afternoon.

At the end of the week you will be issued with a certificate and badge to show your achievement from this challenging week.

You can provide your own lunch and drinks or buy a meal at the ski-centre.

The cost of this activity includes transport to the centre, hire of all equipment and the tuition by a qualified instructor.

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## FISHING



Code: 6    Cost: £110.00 (£30 deposit)    Places available: 15

This activity will be based at Bake Lakes, Trerulefoot for the 5 days.

The activity is open to all abilities – whether you have never fished before or would like to develop your fishing skills and techniques.

You will need to provide your own lunch and plenty of drinks.

The cost of this activity includes transport to the lake, hire of all equipment and the tuition by a qualified instructor.

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TRAIL RIDERS



Code: 7 Cost: £33.00 (£10 deposit) Places available: 15

Like bikes? Want to test yourself off-road and improve your riding?

This activity gives you the chance to develop your riding and then put your skills to the test at some of the best mountain bike spots in the South West. You will ride a wide range of terrain including beautiful cross country loops, man-made dirt jumps and challenging, flowing downhill tracks.

The first part of the week will involve learning how to maintain and service your bike before moving on to developing your riding skills in a controlled area. We will then be travelling to different riding spots each day including Haldon Forest, Lanhydrock, Tamar trails and Cardinham Woods.

You will need to provide your own lunch and plenty of drinks.

You will need a working mountain bike, a helmet and a healthy love of adrenaline to join us! You will need to bring your bike into College to be safety checked prior to the week.

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## LOOKING GOOD, FEELING GOOD



Code: 8    Cost: £30.00 (£10 deposit)    Places available: 30

Fancy spending 5 days 'looking good, feeling good'? You will learn about fashions, fitness and healthy eating through the decades.

Monday to Thursday will be spent in school and on Friday the group will travel to Plymouth to visit a leading department store.

Activities will include:

- ✿ research the decades: discover what fashion and make-up looked like
- ✿ create a 'mood board'
- ✿ taking part in a dance/movement/fitness activity which will make you feel good whatever your ability
- ✿ a visit to the College's own hair and beauty salon
- ✿ experiment with nail art and beauty products – for hygiene/allergy reasons you will need to provide your own make-up and nail varnish
- ✿ research and design an outfit from your chosen decade
- ✿ take part in a fashion show
- ✿ learn about healthy eating and nutrition - what is good for you and what is not.

On Friday the group will travel by coach to Plymouth to visit a leading department store and will learn about the business side of the fashion industry and the role of the personal shopper.

Students will need to provide their own lunch on Friday or take money to buy food in Plymouth.

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URBAN ART ATTACK & DOODLE DESIGN



Code: 9 Cost: £23.50 (£10 deposit) Places available: 20

This is a school based all week activity.


During the week the group will study several doodle/urban artists. You will also take part in a workshop led by a visiting illustrative artist and experience first-hand how commercial public art is created.

You will be given a design brief about an area within the school that requires some design input and will have opportunity to add visual messages using an artist's technique. There will be access to some ICT for creating some stencils and Photoshop imagery.

You will be given a sketch book to use as a visual diary, which is yours to take home at the end of the week. This will help you to gather inspiration and note down ideas. There may also be an opportunity to use a range of materials, including some printing, where you can either stencil or create another image from their inspiration.

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## CONSERVATION WEEK



Co de: 10      Cost: £38.00 (£10 deposit)      Places available: 12

The 5 days will be based at the Westcountry Wildlife Centre based in Broadwoodwidge. The centre was established in 2009 by naturalist Derek Gow. Natural wildlife is abundant with well-established populations of red and roe deer, badgers, foxes and otters. Barn owls and ravens are common together with a range of smaller bird species such as meadow pipits, goldfinches, linnets and yellowhammers.

During the week you will take part in a range of conservation projects in our local community.

There will also be the opportunity to photograph a range of wildlife, creating amazing close up images.

You will need to provide your own lunch and plenty of drinks.

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COFFEE SHOP



Code: 11 Cost: No Charge Places available: 12

This is a school based all week activity.

During the week the group will be running the infamous Launceston College Café. Students will be making all of the pastries and cakes and learning new skills. There will be workshops on soups and breads during the week, allowing students to learn how to make brilliant breads and superb soups! Experiments with cake-making and taste testing the produce are another great aspect of the fun food week.

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## SCINTILLATING SCIENCE



Code: 12

Cost: No Charge

Places available: 20

This activity is based in College.

Rockets, slime and solving crimes....

During the week we will be using scientific experiments and investigations for a variety of tasks. The week will be packed with exciting topics to inspire a deeper understanding of your scientific thinking.

You will be amazed at how science is linked to everything in life.

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SISTER ACT



Code: 13

Cost: No Charge

This activity is an all week activity.

Based on the hit film, Sister Act tells the hilarious story of Deloris Van Cartier, a disco diva whose life takes a surprising turn when she witnesses a murder. Under protective custody she is hidden in the one place she won't be found – a Convent! Disguised as a nun and under the suspicious watch of Mother Superior, Deloris helps her fellow sisters find their voices as she unexpectedly rediscovers her own.

If you want to perform in the production you must have attended the auditions. There are also backstage roles available. Please sign up if you are interested in make-up/set design/lighting etc.

This is a fun filled and rewarding week however it does require a high level of commitment. You may be expected to stay until 4:15 each day of the rehearsals with a possible extra rehearsal on Saturday 7th July. If you sign up for this activity you are also confirming your commitment to show week, evening performances will be from Tuesday 10th July until Saturday 14th July. If you have signed up for a backstage role you will be expected to help at least one evening of the performance week.

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## DAILY ACTIVITIES IN AND FROM SCHOOL

Pupils can pick and choose between these activities, either doing one activity all week or a variety. The deposit is £30 unless the total cost for the week is less than £30 at which point it is the full cost of the week.

### SPORTS (Monday to Friday – choose your day/s)



Code: 14

Cost: No Charge

Places available: 30

This is a school based activity. You can choose to do 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 days of varied sports activities.

Compete against others in a variety of sporting activities and games such as football, ultimate Frisbee, cricket, volleyball, rugby and many more. Some of the activities may be repeated on different days.

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ART – Totem Poles (Monday only)



Code: 15

Cost: £7.50


Places available: 30

This is a school based activity. Learn about environmental sculptures to help you to create and design your own totem pole using clay.

You may also have the opportunity to create a group totem pole which will be displayed in the Adventure Learning Centre.

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### ANIMAL ADVENTURE (Monday only)



Code: 16

Cost: £18.50

Places available: 30

Travel by coach to Feadon Farm at Portreath.

You will be able to get up close and personal with a variety of animals that include goats, reindeer, foxes and much more. Help with feeding the animals. Learn all about the animals in the education centre.

Watch the owls and bats in flight and then end the day with the tame foxes, Todd, Meadow and Copper.

Packed lunch and drinks required.

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INDOOR CLIMBING *(Monday only)*



Code: 17 Cost: £15.50

Places available: 45

You will be taught the basics of climbing on the purpose built climbing wall at The Barn Climbing Centre at Milton Abbot. You will also have the chance to experience top roping, bouldering and slacklining.

Activities will be led by a qualified instructor and a full safety briefing will be given. All equipment will be provided. You will need to wear trainers or similar shoes.

You will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks.

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## **ART – DRAWING ON PLASTER** *(Tuesday only)*



Code: 18    Cost: £7.50

Places available: 30

This is a school based activity.

Learn the techniques for creating a drawing on plaster. This means that instead of just creating a drawing you will be making a 'drawing object'.

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WHAT'S IN THE GARDEN? *(Tuesday only)*



Code: 19 Cost: £4.50

Places available: 20

This activity is based within the Adventure Learning Centre.

Horticultural based activities including soil preparation, sowing, planting, harvesting, pruning, and weeding activities in and around our garden whilst learning about why everything is where it is. This activity may also include an introduction to bee-keeping with Mr Hicks.

Suitable clothing will be needed as you will be based outside whatever the weather. Wellington boots, gloves and work-suits are available if required. You will need to bring your own packed lunch. Drinks, snacks, strawberries and ice cream are thrown in!

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**WILDLIFE EXPERIENCE**  
**(Tuesday only)**



Code: 20    Cost: £18.50

Places available: 30

Travel by coach to Feadon Farm at Portreath.

Take a walk down to the local woods with a Feadon ranger to see the local wildlife inhabitants. Spend time in the education centre seeing wildlife exhibits – take part in a wildlife quiz.

Packed lunch and drinks are required.

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GOLFING
(Tuesday only)



Code: 21 Cost: £9.00

Places available: 12

Try your hand at golf, whether you are a beginner or Rory Mcilroy you can enjoy a day of golf at Trethorne using the range, putting green and on the course.

You can choose to have a day of professional golf coaching at Trethorne Golf Club with Andrew Milton, resident and qualified PGA Professional.

This activity is open to all abilities of golfer. All equipment will be provided but you must wear a plain polo shirt, tailored shorts or trousers (no jeans or sports shorts) and a cap. You will also need to take a change of footwear.

You will need to arrange your own transport to and from Trethorne. Packed lunch and drinks required.

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**DESIGN A BAG**  
**(Tuesday only)**



Code: 22    Cost: £5.50

Places available: 25

This is a school based activity.

Create your own design on a canvas tote bag.

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ART – MUSICAL ART
(Wednesday only)



Code: 18 Cost: £7.50

Places available: 30

This is a school based activity.

You will produce a mixed media piece of art work using your senses! This includes drawing to music and drawing through the sense of touch.

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**WOODLAND LIFE**  
**(Wednesday only)**



Code: 24 Cost: £4.50

Places available: 20

This activity is based within the Adventure Learning Centre.

Learn how great the outdoors is. Get down and dirty identifying and learning about horticulture, environmental work and identifying flora and fauna, through forest conservation based activities.

Suitable clothing will be needed as you will be based outside whatever the weather. Wellington boots, gloves and work-suits are available if required. You will need to bring your own packed lunch. Drinks, snacks, strawberries and ice cream are thrown in!

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PLYMOUTH AQUARIUM
(Wednesday only)



Code: 25 Cost: £13.50

Places available: 60

On the guided tour be inspired by the 50 live exhibits including 3 massive tanks, the largest of which – Britain's deepest tank – holds 2.5 million litres of water. Over 4000 animals from 400 species are displayed in realistic habitats from local shorelines to coral reefs. In the aquarium zone, Explorocean focuses on ocean exploration and sustainability through innovative, interactive exhibits.

You will take part in an 'Under the Knife' workshop.

Packed lunch and drinks required.

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**SCRATCH ART**  
**(Wednesday only)**



Code: 26 Cost: £5.50

Places available: 25

This is a school based activity.

Fancy yourself as a bit of an artist? Like to show off your skills? Come along to scratch art where you will get to do two large scratch art animal pictures as well as some smaller and simpler ones.

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ART – THEATRE DESIGN
(Thursday & Friday – 2 day activity)



Code: 27 Cost: £8.50

Places available: 20

This is a school based 2 day activity.

An introduction to theatre design and modelling using techniques used by architects, designers and engineers. Create a 3D model to take home of a theatre stage. Learn about scale, prop making, lighting and backdrop painting.

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**COOK ALFRESCO!**  
**(Thursday only)**



Code: 28 Cost: £5.50

Places available: 20

This is a school based activity within the Adventure Learning Centre.

Tickle your taste buds, practise using vegetable knives to prepare food and be creative in how and what you eat.

Breakfast, lunch and afternoon tea are all made outside using Kelly kettles, an open fire, brazier, pizza oven and, if made in time, BBQ. Learn how to prepare and cook using basic ingredients. All ingredients will be provided.

Suitable clothing will be needed as you will be based outside whatever the weather. Wellington boots, gloves and work-suits are available if required.

If very wet outdoor conditions, alternative cooking arrangements will be made.

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SKATE 'n' SWIM
(Thursday only)



Code: 29

Cost: £17.00

Places available: 60

Travel by coach to Plymouth Pavilions to take part in an ice skating session (skates included).

After lunch you will then travel to Meadowlands in Tavistock for a full 'wet'n'wild' session in the fun pool.

You will need to bring your swimwear and a towel.

Packed lunch and drinks required.

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**TREE SURFING**  
**(Friday only)**



Code: 30

Cost: £33.50

Places available: 45

Challenge your balance and co-ordination on the three adrenaline-fuelled treetop ropes courses. You'll climb 50 feet up into the woodland canopy and then weave through the trees on the specially designed trail. Test your Tarzan-ometer ratings on a range of intricately constructed swings, bridges, wooden walkways and zip wires. The journey is guaranteed to be a challenge, but you'll always be linked up to a harness for safety.

Activities will be led by a qualified instructor. A full safety briefing will be given before you leave the ground. All equipment will be provided. You will need to wear trainers, walking boots or similar shoes. This is an outside activity so you will need to wear clothing suitable for the weather on the day.

You will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks.

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NEWQUAY ZOO
(Friday only)



Code: 31

Cost: £13.00

Places available: 60

Travel by coach to Newquay Zoo. You will take part in a rainforest workshop and have time to explore the Zoo.

Then you can enjoy the rest of the day getting closer to over 130 species. See the penguins relaxing in their pool, visit the creepiest crawlies in the atmospheric tropical house, watch the big cats get their lunch and learn more about conservation.

Animals at the zoo include lion, lynx, antelope, monkeys, panda, tapir, capybara, mongoose, wildebeest, sloth, zebras and the collection of bugs and reptiles.
