Unit descriptions

Unit 1 - Students will learn about the different types of organisations in the travel & tourism sector and how they interrelate. They will investigate the history of travel & tourism and how current trends and events affect this sector.

Unit 2 - Students will be able to locate important travel & tourism locations in the UK and what they have to offer the tourist. They will create resources to assist tourist both from the UK and abroad.

Unit 3 - Students will be able to locate important travel & tourism locations around the world and what they have to offer the tourist. They will learn to plan and create custom holiday packages to meet a client's needs.

Entry Requirements

5 GCSE's at 9-4 including English and maths.

Possible progression routes – It could lead to numerous courses in travel and tourism or hospitality as well as higher apprenticeships.
