The basics

- A state funded secondary school
- Students from 11 to 18 years
- Serves the town of Launceston and surrounding villages
- Approximately 1300 students
- We are in a Multi-Academy Trust along with 2 other secondary schools and 3 primary schools



The curriculum

11 to 16 years

Students study the following courses and take their GCSEs at the age of 16:

English, Mathematics, Science
History or Geography
Spanish or French
Physical Education and Religious Education
2 subjects of their choice

Students wear a uniform

16 to 18 years

Students choose four subjects and take their A level examinations when they are 18. Students choose their own curriculum.

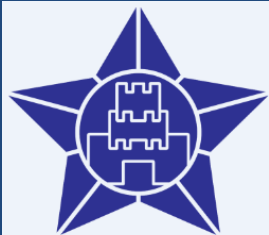
The students will then go to university or start employment.

Students do not need to wear a uniform

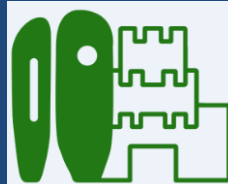
Houses

Houses are named after prominent people from Cornwall.



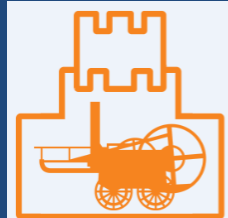
