

# Exam concession: Rest breaks

## Invigilator's guide

- The timing of the examination should be paused and re-started when the candidate is ready to continue.
- During the supervised rest break the candidate must not have access to the question paper/answer booklet.
- If the candidate needs to leave the examination room, an invigilator must accompany the candidate. There is no maximum time set for supervised rest breaks but there will be some constraints on timing if the candidate has more than one exam in a day.
